- What did you learn from, take away from, or get out of this book?
- Would this book make a good movie? Why or why not?
- Where did the book take place? How would it be different if it took place at your school or in your hometown?
- Would you recommend this book to a friend? Why or why not?
- How did the author create and keep your interest?
- Why did you choose this book to read and share?
